Help us deliver an inspiring creative programme at Provan Hall to excite and engage our local community.

About Provan Hall:

Provan Hall is an A listed medieval building located in Auchinlea Park, which sits at the heart of Easterhouse. The building has undergone a £3m restoration that will safeguard this important heritage asset as a new hub for heritage learning and engagement, and a visitor gateway to the Seven Lochs Wetland Park.

Following its restoration, Provan Hall is managed and operated by charity, Provan Hall Community Management Trust. The aim of the Trust is to engage and inspire local people in their heritage by providing opportunities that connect people to Provan Hall through inclusive means of creative and artistic interpretation.

About the Role:

We invite applications from creative organisations or collectives across various platforms to produce Halloween and Christmas themed performances and/or events at Provan Hall in 2024 for the local community and schools.

Project fee: £8000.00

The fee is inclusive of preparation time, performance and all materials and props.

Target audiences: Families and schools

Project schedule: Schedule is flexible depending on preparation time but we envisage approximately between 6-8 performances days during the Halloween and Christmas seasons.

As this is a freelance opportunity, public liability is required from organisations/individual creatives engaged at Provan Hall and an up to date and appropriate membership of Disclosure Scotland will be required for any artist who is engaged in regular work with protected children or adult groups.
